Executive Order 17-03

- Signed by Gov. Greitens January 10, 2017
- All state agencies involved in initiative
- June 30, 2018 deadline for proposed rulemaking
- Clean Water – 47 rules
 - 1 new rule
 - 13 rescissions
 - 33 amendments

Second Executive Order 18-04 for RTR

- Signed by Gov. Parson June 29, 2018
- Extended deadline to September 30, 2018
- Department rules were all filed by Ex. Order 17-03 June deadline
- WPP rules on schedule with a rule effective date of February 28, 2019

RTR Process

- Numerous stakeholder meetings for RTR discussion were held throughout January and February of 2018
- A Public Hearing for Chapter 1 & 4 proposed rescissions was held on March 14, 2018
- A Public Hearing for Chapters 2 proposed rulemaking was held on July 16, 2018
- A Public Hearing for Chapter 4, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 14 proposed rulemaking will be held on August 15, 2018

- Chapter 8-Design Guides - 2 Rescissions, 13 Amendments, 1 New Rule
- Chapter 9-Treatment Plant Operations - 3 Amendments
- Chapter 14-Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Waste Management System Operations - 2 Amendments
