CHAPTER 8 STAKEHOLDER

2016 UPDATE

Strategy

The department plans to rescind 10 CSR 20-8.020 and incorporate the small design guide into the large design guide rules with exceptions as appropriate. As a result, there will be only one reference for any size wastewater treatment facility. The department hopes this amendment will reduce confusion and streamline the rulemaking process in the future.

The department is proposing amending 10 CSR 20-8.110 through 10 CSR 20-8.210 through the same rulemaking folder process. Each rule will have multiple scheduled stakeholder discussions. After all the rules have been through the stakeholder process, the department will proceed with one encompassing rulemaking report, regulatory impact report (RIR), and fiscal note. The department believes presenting all of the domestic wastewater Chapter 8 rules as a whole will better represent costs and impacts rather than focusing on a single component in a wastewater system. Also, this proposal will reduce the rulemaking schedule by an estimated two years.

Timeline

We anticipate completing stakeholder meetings in 2016. In 2017, we intend to draft and finalize the RIR and fiscal note. Finally in 2018, we look forward to the chapter 8 rulemakings becoming effective.

New:

The department is developing a new rule, 10 CSR 20-8.125 Alternative Sewers, to address alternative sewers separate from conventional gravity sewers.

Combining:

The department elected to combine 10 CSR 20-8.200 Wastewater Treatment Ponds (Lagoons) and 10 CSR 20-8.220 Land Treatment due to their direct correlation.

Rescinding:

The department plans to rescind 10 CSR 20-8.020 Design of Small Sewage Works and 10 CSR 20-8.220 Land Treatment.
