Dear Ms. Parker-Pauley:

By this letter I am petitioning the Department of Natural Resources according to the provisions of Section 536.041 RSMo to subject a document titled STATE OF MISSOURI GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR NATIONWIDE PERMITS to the rulemaking process for adoption or amendment. For convenience and for identification purposes there is a copy of the document attached to this correspondence.

The document has not been included on the list provided by you to the joint committee on administrative rules by letter of September 10, 2013 in response to the committee's letter dated June 12, 2013. Also, unless it has been revised since last year it does not comply with the provisions of Section 640.026.2 which would serve to more precisely define the document.

While the document carries no identification other than the title it is clear that it originated from within the Department of Natural Resources. Also, the document is clearly a statement of general applicability used to implement law and administrative actions, and therefore should be codified as an administrative rule so that it would be readily available to Missouri stakeholders who are subject to its provisions.

The STATE OF MISSOURI GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR NATIONWIDE PERMITS has been the subject of correspondence with your agency for several years so this petition will not come as a surprise, and there should be no cause to apply to the joint committee on administrative rules for an extension of the sixty day period allowed for a response.
