


## How to Access and Login to MoGEM and Navigate to eDMR

To access eDMR you will first have to have an account in the Missouri Gateway for Environmental Management (MoGEM). This guide will help you navigate the Department's website and find the MoGEM splash page (<https://dnr.mo.gov/mogem/>) with information on account registration and login access. Then it will show you how to access eDMR, one of the Department's many eServices, once you login.

**Step 1:** From the DNR Website (<https://dnr.mo.gov/>) click on 'Online Services' located on the green bar at the top of the screen.



**Step 2:** Under the subheader Multi-use click on link for 'Missouri Gateway for Environmental Management (MoGEM)'.

## Missouri Gateway for Environmental Management - MoGEM



The Missouri Gateway for Environmental Management (MoGEM) online portal is used by the regulated community to conduct business with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MoDNR). This portal is a login mechanism which allows the regulated community a centralized location to manage services for your organization within MoGEM.

The current services in MoGEM are listed below and services will continue to be added to allow further permitting and reporting. In order to use these services you must register through the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Shared CROMERR Services (SCS) (<https://encromerr.epa.gov/>) or log in to MoGEM (portal) with existing credentials.

**Step 5:** Under Programs next to eDMR select a role from the dropdown and click ‘Proceed to program with selected role’.

**NOTE:** The role selected is not the role that the user has for each facility. This is the MoGEM role and for eDMR it only indicates if the user has an eSignature (Org Official/Certifier) or does not have an eSignature (Preparer/Viewer).

**NOTE:** User will have a specific role for each facility within eDMR eService.
