**Priority Point System & General SRF Regulation
Stakeholders Meeting Summary
April 12, 2007**

A rough draft of a proposed priority point regulation was distributed to stakeholders and discussed. The stakeholders believed that several areas needed to be refined so that the communities, consultants and department staff would better understand how priority points would be assigned.

- Factor B-2: wastewater treatment plant improvements will be revised to clearly state how priority points will be assigned.
- Factor B-3 and E-2: on-site systems will be revised. Stakeholders felt that defining a specific percentage of failing on-site systems in an area may prove to be too difficult. A more generic approach should be used.
- Factor E-3: leaking underground storage tanks should be revised to include above ground storage tanks as well. Change to petroleum storage tanks.
- Factor E-4: hazardous waste. Consideration should also be given to special wastes.
- Clarification is needed when assigning priority points to an application that is for refinancing.

Consensus of the group is that the draft fairly well represents what needs to be considered for establishing priority points. Water Protection Program staff are to prepare a draft regulation for review and discussion prior to the next meeting.
