You are invited to participate in a discussion on revisions to the Public Drinking Water Branch's *Standards for Non-Community Public Water Supplies*. This document has not been revised since 1982. The revised standards will be called Minimum Design Standards for Missouri Non-Community Public Water Systems.

Standards for Non-Community Public Water Supplies is part of the drinking water regulations and can only be revised by going through the rulemaking process. The department anticipates that the stakeholder meeting on Feb. 10 will be the only meeting prior to the formal rulemaking process. The rulemaking process will include a public hearing and public comment period later this year.

What is the Minimum Design Standards for Missouri Non-community Public Water Systems?

Once finalized, this document will update minimum design standards for the construction or modification of all non-community public drinking water systems in the state. This document replaces the 1982 publication *Standards for Non-Community Public Water Supplies*.

What is this meeting about?

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the revisions with stakeholders prior to beginning the rulemaking process.
