

### **Source Water Protection Development and Implementation Grant Program (SWPDI)**

Primary community public water systems (systems that produce their own water from a natural source) are eligible to fund a variety of projects through this financial assistance program. Eligible projects include development of a preliminary source water protection or wellhead protection plan or implementation of protective measures designed to prevent additional contamination of the water system's raw water source. Awarded projects listed here include abandoned well plugging projects, preliminary plan development projects, wellhead security projects and informational/educational projects. All projects are funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Set-Asides as authorized by the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. ### **Abandoned Well Plugging Grant Program (AWP)**

Any public water system that has an active or emergency groundwater well is eligible to apply for financial assistance to properly plug abandoned water wells that may provide a conduit of contamination into the aquifer used as a raw water source for the public water system. The awarded projects listed here include projects to locate, identify and plug abandoned water wells. Eligible water systems may also use available funds to promote education for their communities in regard to the dangers of abandoned wells. All projects are funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Set-Asides as authorized by the federal Safe Drinking Water Act.
