Dear Ms. Lawyer:

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Water Protection Program has reviewed and approved the plans and specifications submitted by Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. for the McDonald County PWSD No. 1, Village of Jane, MO. Construction Permit No. CPSE00029 is enclosed with this letter. This permit will terminate 20 months from the date of issuance; however, the Department may grant an extension. If you believe that an extension is necessary, you must submit a request and a justification for the extension at least 30 days prior to the permit expiration date.

Please find enclosed one set of approved specifications. One set of approved plans has been sent (under separate cover) by Ms. Cynthia Smith, of my staff. You must maintain these with your official project file for a minimum of four (4) years following completion of the project. The Department, prior to implementation, must approve any changes to the approved plans and specifications.

State and Federal Law does not permit bypassing of raw sewage; therefore, you must take steps to ensure that raw sewage does not discharge during construction.

When construction is complete, your consulting engineer must submit the enclosed form entitled "Statement of Work Completed" along with a request for a final inspection.

You may appeal to have the matter heard by the Administrative Hearing Commission. To appeal, you must file a petition with the Administrative Hearing Commission within 30 days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed. If it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the Administrative Hearing Commission.

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources hereby issues a permit to:

Construction of such proposed facilities shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Missouri Clean Water Law, Chapter 644, RSMo, and regulation promulgated there under, or this permit may be revoked by the Department of Natural Resources.

As the Department of Natural Resources does not examine structural features of design or the efficiency of mechanical equipment, the issuance of this permit does not include approval of these features.

A representative of the department may inspect the work covered by this permit during construction. Issuance of a permit to Operate by the department will be contingent on the work substantially adhering to the approved plans and specifications.

This permit applies only to the construction of water pollution control components; it does not apply to other environmentally regulated areas.

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

COLLECTION SYSTEM

This project will construct a wastewater collection system that will serve the Village of Jane. The collection system will connect the village to the Bella Vista, Arkansas wastewater treatment plant. The project consists of two sections.

Section 1 includes, but is not limited to, the construction of the following:

- approximately 3,869 linear feet of 15 inch diameter gravity sewer
- approximately 1,290 linear feet of 12 inch diameter gravity sewer
- approximately 2,286 linear feet of 10 inch diameter gravity sewer
- approximately 18,124 linear feet of 8 inch diameter gravity sewer
- approximately 7,072 linear feet of 12 inch diameter pressure sewer

Section 2 includes, but is not limited to, the construction of the following:

- approximately 2,426 linear feet of 10 inch diameter gravity sewer
- approximately 3,604 linear feet of 8 inch diameter gravity sewer
- approximately 1,754 linear feet of 10 inch diameter pressure sewer
- approximately 9,768 linear feet of 12 inch diameter pressure sewer
- Lift Station 3 – duplex pump station with each pump delivering 500 gallons per minute against a total dynamic head of 89.1 feet. Pump motors will be 30 horsepower maximum.
- Lift Station 4 – duplex pump station with each pump delivering 700 gallons per minute against a total dynamic head of 158.3 feet. Pump motors will be 65 horsepower maximum.

The project will also include general site work appropriate to the scope and purpose of the project.

PERMIT CONDITIONS:

1. All construction shall be in accordance with the plans and specifications submitted by Allgeier, Martin & Associates, Inc. on March 11, 2010 and approved by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources on April 30, 2010.
2. Regulation 10 CSR 20-4.023(19) requires that projects be publicly advertised, allowing sufficient time for bids to be prepared and submitted.
3. No land disturbance work shall commence until a land disturbance permit has been obtained from the Department unless the work is exempted in accordance with 10 CSR 20-6.200. Contact the Department's Southwest Regional Office for additional information.
4. The Department must be contacted prior to making any changes in the approved plans and specifications that would directly or indirectly have an impact on the capacity or reliability of the proposed sewerage works or any design parameter that is addressed by 10 CSR 20-8.
5. As per 10 CSR 20-4.023 (6)(B)4, all changes in contract price or time within the approved scope of work must be by change order in accordance with this rule.
6. The construction permit will terminate 20 months from the date of issuance unless justification is presented for extension. During the construction of this project, the bypassing of raw sewage will not be permitted.
