

3.3.1.10 Overview of the Permit/General Permits/Statewide GP Template/ Duty to Comply

Applicability:

This topic applies only to writers of the statewide general permit templates.

Content:

The following language is to be inserted into every general permit template. It provides notice to the permit holder of the consequences of non-compliance. Regulation or statute does not require it, but it is department practice to include it.

DUTY OF COMPLIANCE

The permittee shall comply with all conditions of this general permit. Any noncompliance with this general permit constitutes a violation of Chapter 644, Missouri Clean Water Law, and 10 CSR 20-6.200. Noncompliance may result in enforcement action, termination of this authorization, or denial of the permittee's request for renewal.

Or

DUTY OF COMPLIANCE

The permittee shall comply with all conditions of this general permit. Any noncompliance with this general permit constitutes a violation of Chapter 644, Missouri Clean Water Law, and 10 CSR 20-6.010. Noncompliance may result in enforcement action, termination of this authorization, or denial of the permittee's request for renewal.
