

3.3.1.9 Overview of the Permit/General Permits/Statewide GP Template/ Termination

Applicability:

This topic applies only to writers of the statewide general permit templates.

Content:

A general permit issued to an individual is terminated by submission of an application for termination and by satisfying the termination requirements of the GP template. It is the responsibility of the writer of the statewide general permit template to ensure that appropriate conditions for termination are listed in the Requirements and Guidelines Section (see 3.3.1.4 Requirements and Guidelines). Such conditions can address storm water and erosion controls, housekeeping practices, management of materials stored in the open, and required practices at the time of facility closure or sale. This may include testing of materials left on site, receipts for sale or transfer of material to another site, approval of a closure plan, etc.

In addition to the conditions listed in the Requirements Section, the following language is included in the template:

Termination of Permit

This permit may be terminated when activities covered by this permit have ceased and no significant materials are stored in such a way as to come into contact with storm water, or if a transfer of ownership of the facility and its activities has been made. If such a termination is sought, the permittee shall submit Form H, Termination of a General Permit.

This language may be customized by the permit writer, for example:

“...activities covered by this permit have ceased...” includes any discharges of process wastewater.

“...no significant materials are stored...” means that storm water runoff will no longer be a concern at the former facility.
