

## 3.5.9 Overview of the Permit/No-Discharge Permits/ Standard Conditions

### Applicability:

Standard Conditions for NPDES Permits apply to all issued permits, including no-discharge permits.

### Content:

No-discharge permits are issued in accord with procedures and requirements for all state operating permits (NPDES Permits) and are to contain conditions to protect public health and the environment (10 CSR 20-6.015(4)(A) and (4)(C)). The Construction and Operating Permit rule provides for the incorporation of appropriate conditions into permits to control discharges and sludge disposal and to ensure compliance (10 CSR 20-6.010(8)(A)1 and (8)(B)).

[Part 1 Standard Conditions](#) apply to all issued permits. These are known federally as “boilerplate” requirements. Section A includes requirements related to monitoring and reporting, test procedures, record keeping, and compliance schedules. Section B relates to management requirements and addresses facilities operations and changes, noncompliance notification, bypassing, handling of residuals, permit modifications and transfers, reapplication and signature requirements, the department’s inspection and record review rights, and various civil and criminal liabilities and rights of the permittee.

[Part 2 Standard Conditions](#) applies to POTW permits and covers requirements that public facilities must enforce when accepting industrial and other wastewaters.

[Part 3 Standard Conditions](#) covers sludge and biosolids management requirements for domestic wastewater treatment facilities. These conditions should be included in most domestic wastewater permits for both POTW and privately owned domestic waste facilities. Part 3 conditions address general requirements, mechanical facility operations, sludge hauling, lagoon treatment and storage, incineration, land application, sludge facility closure, monitoring, reporting and record keeping.
