

4.1.5.1 Application and Review Process/Permit Process/ Transfers/Overview

Applicability:

This topic applies to all transfers of operating permits. Construction permits are not transferable.

Content:

In order to transfer an operating permit, the permittee and the potential permittee must submit an Application for Transfer of Operating Permit. The application includes identifying information and the signatures of the current owner and the new owner, and a modification fee. The fee varies by permit type. Completed application forms should be sent to the appropriate regional office. See Other Links below.

Transfers are considered Minor Modifications and do not require public notice. The permit is modified and issued to the new owner. Until such time as the permit is modified, the original owner retains responsibility for the facility.

Business name and address changes where the owner, operator and continuing authority remain the same are not considered transfers.

Not all General Permits are transferable. You must check the conditions of a General Permit before processing an Application for Transfer.
