

4.6.4.2.2 Application and Review Process/Completing Permit Application Forms/ Attaching Supplemental Information/Additional Site Specific Permit Requirements/ No-Discharge Management Plan

Applicability:

This topic applies to no-discharge facilities.

Content:

An Operation & Maintenance (O&M) plan should be developed by all wastewater facilities. In order to be complete, the plan for no-discharge facilities should include special provisions for management of wastewater or solids so as to maintain no-discharge status. Additionally, a plan should detail procedures for disposal of wastewater or solids, such as land application, pump and haul, etc. When that procedure is not available, a back-up method should be specified.

The O&M plan should be included with the application for the construction permit in most instances. The operational practices of a no-discharge facility need to be determined during the design phase so that land application sites, site characteristics, application schedules, contact information and similar details are understood and factored into the design and operational methods. The O&M Plan should be reviewed and updated regularly and revised when changes are made at the facility.
