

4.6.4.2.3 Completing Permit Application Forms/ Attaching Supplemental Information/Additional Site Specific Permit Requirements/ POTW Pretreatment Program Submittal

Applicability:

Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTWs) that have been required by the Department to develop a pretreatment program (or have decided to develop such a program on their own) must submit program documents for review and approval.

Content:

All pretreatment program submittals shall be forwarded to the Pretreatment Coordinator, Water Pollution Control Program. The pretreatment program submittal must contain:

1. a statement from the City Solicitor or attorney that the POTW has authority adequate to carry out the programs described in 40 CFR 403.8,
2. copies of the statutes or ordinances upon which the pretreatment program is based,
3. a description of the POTW organization that will administer the pretreatment program, and
4. a description of funding levels and staffing for the pretreatment program.

The Pretreatment Coordinator shall review all submittals and comment when appropriate. Once the submittal is deemed complete, the Coordinator shall prepare a Public Notice of the Department's intent to approve the program. Upon completion of the public notice period and the resolution of any comments that were received, the Coordinator shall prepare a formal approval letter to be signed by the Director of Staff of the Missouri Clean Water Commission.
