

4.7.4.2.1.2 Application and Review Process/Review of the Permit Application/ Technical Review/Application for Permit Modification at Existing Facility/ General Permits/Agricultural Chemical

Applicability:

This outlines procedures for permitting physical changes to existing Agrichemical Facilities and modifying the General Permits for those facilities.

Content:

Agrichemical facilities are defined in 10 CSR 20-2.010(3). Applications for a construction permit to make physical changes to an existing facility are processed like construction permits for a new facility.

The construction permit application is processed in the central office. The submission consists of a completed Form A-Application for Construction or Operating Permit with applicable fee, an engineering report with plans and specifications for the modification and the required map.

Review of the plans and specifications along with required information is the same as for a new facility. Please refer to [4.7.4.1.1.2](#).

An application for a modified General Permit (operating permit) is processed in the central office and shall consist of a Form E - Application for General Permit with applicable fee and certification from the project engineer that the facility was constructed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications. The existing permit number will be used. Again, refer to [4.7.4.1.1.2](#) for related procedures.
