



# Regulations


- NPDES Regulations
  - 40 CFR Parts 9, 122, 123, 124 (**expected revisions to be proposed 2012**)
  - 10 CSR 20-6.200
- Regulated MS4s
  - Phase Is – 100,000+ pop/2000 Census
  - Phase IIs
    - 1,000+ within Urbanized Areas
    - 10,000+ outside Urbanized Areas
