Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in September 2007 and no WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted during the survey. However, a 2005 interview cites whole body contact uses and secondary contact uses including: swimming, fishing, wading, and baptisms. Evidence of secondary contact (ATV tracks) was observed during the survey.

Is the evaluated use attainable?  Yes  No

Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 3 out of 7 sites evaluated. Due to the stream meeting the maximum depth criterion and documented existing use, the committee recommends the WBCR use designation be retained. Due to evidence and documented secondary contact, the committee recommends Secondary Contact Recreation be assigned.
