Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in April 2008 and no WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted during the survey, and no comments were received. A small rock dam with creek access was documented at site 2, and boat access was documented at site 16.

Is the evaluated use attainable?  Yes  No

Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 11 out of 17 sites evaluated and met median depth criterion at 4 out of 17 sites. Due to the stream meeting these depth criteria the committee recommends the WBCR use designation be retained. Due to documented evidence of secondary contact, the committee recommends Secondary Contact Recreation be assigned.
