Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in October 2007 and no WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted during the survey. No evidence of secondary contact was observed during the survey.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream did not meet the depth criteria at any of the 3 sites evaluated. Due to not meeting the depth criteria and no evidence of existing use, the committee recommends the WBCR use designation be removed. However, Stream Team has 10 monitoring sites upstream on the unclassified segment, which runs through a residential area. The committee recommends that the class C designation be extended upstream at least as far as the Stream Team sites and that Secondary Contact Recreation be assigned.
