Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in August 2008 and no WBCR was observed. There was evidence of a cement crossing through the stream at site #1 and tire tracks on both the east and west banks of the creek suggesting possible SCR. No interviews were conducted during this survey and no comments were received in 2008.

Comments: The maximum depth criteria were met at 2 of 3 sites for WBCR. No interviews or comments were given in 2008 UAA. The committee recommends that WBCR be retained and SCR be added.
