SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

PIN OAK CREEK- WBID 0926

JULY 11, 2006

I looked at the creek at the following points: CR 200 bridge and CR 75 bridge. There wasn't a lot of water, however some was present. There is a nice new house next to the creek at CR 200. No one was home at the residence, but I noticed that there were lilies planted on the creek bank and there could be a nice sized pool around the bend near the house. I would estimate not more than 1 foot of water was in the creek at its deepest point. There was a child's swimming pool in the yard.

I interviewed two people:

Dois Enke: Mrs Enke lives at 1210 SW 75. She said she never knew anyone that used the creek and did not ever see anyone swimming or wading. She said the creek never had more than 2 inches in it or it was dry where she is most of the year.

Ms. Holsey: Ms Holsey lives at 124 SW CR 124. She did not know anything about the creek and had never seen anyone using the creek.

It appeared to me that, unless the creek was dammed up somewhere, it lacked the depth to swim in.
