Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in December 2008 and no WBCR was observed. A footpath and a platform were observed at site 3. No interviews were conducted.

Comments: The stream met the median depth criterion at 2 of 7 sites evaluated. Because the stream met the median depth criterion, the committee recommends that the WBCR use designation be retained. Due to evidence of secondary contact recreation (SCR), the committee recommends that the SCR use be assigned.
