Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in August 2008 and no evidence of WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream did not meet the maximum or median depth criteria for WBCR. These findings are consistent with the 2005 UAA. Because the stream did not meet the depth criteria and there is no evidence of existing use, the committee recommends that the WBCR use designation be removed.
