Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in August 2008 and no evidence of WBCR was observed. A 2005 UAA interview cited wading and hunting as uses occurring on this stream. A comment received in 2009 also cited playing and wading. No interviews were conducted in the 2008 UAA.


Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream did not meet the maximum or median depth criteria for WBCR. These findings are consistent with the 2005 UAA. Because the depth criteria was not met and there is no evidence of existing use, the committee recommends that the WBCR use designation be removed. Due to evidence of secondary contact recreation (SCR), the committee recommends that the SCR use be assigned.
