Rescheduling: You may not reschedule your test more than two times. If you do not take the test after the second reschedule, your application will be cancelled and you must re-apply to take the test. You will receive notification of the time and place you are scheduled for testing.

Testing Site: Department of Natural Resources, Missouri Geological Survey, Annex Building, 1251 Gale Drive, Rolla MO 65401.

At all times, a non-restricted contractor or an apprentice who has completed the required number of installations must be on site.

TYPES OF PERMITS

Non-Restricted Permit: This permit is for the contractor who is responsible for the work performed; i.e., drills the well or installs the pump. The contractor must be an apprentice for two years and perform the required number of installations prior to qualifying for a non-restricted permit.

Restricted Permit: This permit allows the contractor to contract the work as a primary contractor to a person who holds a non-restricted permit or to be an on-site supervisor. The restricted permittee is equally responsible for the work performed by the non-restricted contractor.

Apprentice Permit: Apprenticeship is for a period of two years, and the apprentice must complete the required amount of installations as outlined in 10 CSR 23-1.050. Upon meeting these requirements, the apprentice may apply for a non-restricted permit.

FEES

Testing Fees: For the restricted and apprentice permits, the applicant will take the general test only (\$50). The general test is an open book test over the Missouri Well Construction Rules. The rules can be viewed at sos.mo.gov/adrules/csr/current/10csr/10csr.asp#10-23. For the non-restricted permit, the applicant will take the general test (\$50), if not taken as an apprentice, and at least one specific test (\$50 each). The specific test is a closed book test about general knowledge gained through experience. A score of 70 percent is required to pass. Any retakes will be \$50 per test. Testing dates will be provided with the application and also are available online at dnr.mo.gov/geology/geosrv/wellhd/testingschedule.htm.
