"Don't Ignore the Light"

All 1996 and newer vehicles are equipped with an on board diagnostic computer, called OBDII. OBD is an early warning system that monitors the vehicle's emission control devices to ensure it's functioning properly. OBD triggers a check engine light when the system notes a repeated emissions-related concern. You can prevent air pollution and possibly avoid expensive emissions repairs if you don't ignore the light!
