Dear Mr. Kramer:

At the January 17, 2012, State Oil and Gas Council meeting held in Jefferson City, MO, Kansas Resource Exploration and Development (KRED) petitioned the council for special project status for the Belton and Clark-Berry leases in Cass County. State regulation 10 CSR 50-2.110 provides the council the authority to grant special consideration to operators who wish to develop projects aimed at producing the state's heavy oil reserves. Operators require a great deal of flexibility in developing well patterns, which include enhanced recovery injection wells to produce oil due to its physical properties.

After discussion by the council, a motion was passed to grant this special project status request. Additional well permits may be applied for with locations determined at the discretion of your office as long as the well is not located within 165 feet of the boundary of the special project.

Belton Lease-----SE ¼ of Section 9, T46N, R33W and part of the NW ¼ and SW ¼  
of Section 16, T46N, R33W containing 560 acres m/l.

Clark-Berry Lease----SE ¼ of Section 16, T46N, R33W and part of the NE ¼ and NW ¼  
of Section 21, T46N, R33W containing 370 acres m/l.


Dear Ms. Levick:

At the January 17, 2012, State Oil and Gas Council meeting held in Jefferson City, MO, Laclede Gas Company petitioned the council for special project status for the Laclede Lease in St. Louis County. The Laclede Lease, aka the Lange Trenton Unit, is located in parts of Section 1, Township 47N, Range 6E; Sections 6 & 7, Township 47N, Range 7E; U.S. Survey Land Grant 360 and 934. The boundary of the special project is delineated by 58 parcels which are comprised of Laclede Gas and private holdings. The attached map and corresponding parcel reference chart make up the lease which was unitized and approved by the council in the 1970's. It is understood that parcels may be subdivided within the unit but the overall unit boundary will not change. State regulation 10 CSR 50-2.110 provides the council the authority to grant special project status to encourage the development of economic recovery of oil and gas reserves in the state.

After discussion by the council, a motion was passed to grant this special project request to Laclede Gas Company. Additional well permits may be applied for with location determined at the discretion of your office provided the well is not located within 165 feet of the boundary of the special project. If additional properties are added to the Laclede Lease in the future, Laclede Gas Company will need to seek council approval to include any new parcels as part of the special project.
