

Dear Sir:

We have completed the Test Drilling of Pratt #1 Well located in Clay county, 7-51-31. The well was drilled to a total depth of 600 feet.

We encountered a show of oil at 399-414 which in my opinion was sufficient to warrant some offset holes if possible.

Our current status is we have capped this well and are having the location surveyed for location. If we can offset this well provided the boundries are sufficient, what are the allowable spacings for producing wells from that depth.

My idea is to offset this well, on two or three sides. My question to you is, can I offset this hole and if so how far away do I have to be or how close can wells be spaced at this depth?

Please advise me as soon as possible.

Good Morning Mike:

We have reviewed the rough plat you furnished for the Pratt #1 well, and it would appear that you would be able to offset this well. Depending on an accurate plat, economics, and reservoir conditions (I hope you saved a good set of samples), spacing on as little as a 2½ acre pattern might be approved. This would keep you the 165 foot minimum from a property line and 330 feet between wells. Allowing for a 5 or 7 spot injection pattern that would just about fill this 40 acre plat.

This is not an "official spacing order" as we would like to hear from you in regard to your recommendation for development, when you send in the surveyed plat.

I hope this is sufficient; however, if you have any questions, please feel free to call on me.
