I am in opposition for the the quarry that Heartland Quarries has proposed in Fruitland on county road 601. I live one and half miles from the proposed site, but this affects me personally in several ways: my parents home, my home, and safety of my children.

My parents live directly across the street where the proposed site would be. They have lived there for the past 32 years. I grew up in that house and now it is a second home to my two young children (3 ½ year old and 20 month old.) My mother watches my 2 children while my husband and I work forty five plus hours a week. They spend a majority of their day outside having fun! I am concerned with the dust and pollutants that could come from this quarry. My youngest son has already had heart surgery at the young age of three months and the possibility of this affecting his health or the health of my oldest worries me. My oldest son goes to Curious Kids Daycare in Fruitland two days a week. This daycare is within a two mile radius as well. How will the quality of air affect the daycare where they play outside. Secondly, the dump trucks that will be coming in and out of the road is a concern. The trucks sit so high up and with small children riding their bikes on the roads I am afraid that they will not always be seen (accidents happen). Another concern is the safety of the water. My parents have well water and it has been stated that the blasting will have affect on that as well. My son and I like taking walks down the road to Hubble creek and looking at the fish, how will that be affected?

I am worried about my property as well. Living so close (within 1 ½ miles) my property value will decrease. The blasting could damage the foundation of the house, crack the basement, and cause leaks. Insurance will not cover this because they do not know if it is because of the blasting or natural settling of the ground.

I do not oppose quarries just the location of them. I do not believe that they belong in neighbors with schools, homes, and other businesses. We request an informal hearing in front of the commission on this matter

To the Land Reclamation Board,

I'm writing to voice my opposition to the Heartland Materials quarry that has applied for a permit to operate in the Fruitland community. I live very close to the proposed quarry site and I have many concerns regarding this permit.

1) My husband and I are both former military and have spent years working for the Department of State in Iraq. We consistently hear explosions in our line of work. When a large noise is heard we are expected to react to it in order to save our lives. When we are home we expect relief from constant fears associated with explosions. Typically it takes two to three weeks at home before we quit jumping at large or distant noises. If there a quarry next our home we won't get any relief from the stress that comes from the noise that blasting will cause.

2) We planned on selling our house in Fruitland at the end of next year and rebuilding on our land which is also in Fruitland. If the quarry operates in the proposed area it will make selling our house very difficult and will drastically decrease the value. I'm also worried that the blasting will affect the house foundation.

3) We planned on having children and having them live and Fruitland *and* attending North Elementary School but that may not be such a good idea if there is a quarry. With fugitive dust in the air, I'm concerned about how it will affect their future health. I believe children have a right to a safe, clean, environment to learn and play in.

4) I live in Fruitland and depend on the Public Water Supply for my family. Fruitland is a very populated area, and thousands depend on this supply daily. There are several public wells within a close proximity to the proposed quarry location. I urge you to complete the proper studies to determine how this could possibly effect our water supply in the future, especially considering the unpredictable Karst typography we live in.

I adamantly oppose this quarry. I respectfully ask that a informal public hearing take place to discuss these issues. I also request that a formal courtroom hearing be granted so that further evidence could be presented to the Land Reclamation Board. Thank you for your consideration.
