To the Land Reclamation Board,

I am writing to voice my opposition to the Strack Excavating quarry that has been proposed in the Fruitland community. I live quite close to this area and I believe it would negatively affect me and my family.

First of all, my husband works a swing shift and is sleeping during the day several days a week. I believe the noise would negatively affect him in getting enough sleep to do his job safely.

Secondly, we live in an older home which has already had to have foundation work done. I believe the blasting could potentially affect these repairs causing us to have to spend even more money to repair them again.

I am also concerned about possible negative effects on the Public Water Supply in this area. Thousands of people including my family rely on this water supply daily. I want to urge you to complete the proper studies to determine how this rock quarry could affect our water supply considering the unpredictable Karst topography seen in the Fruitland area.

Lastly, I have two children, one of which attends North Elementary School here in Fruitland. The negative air quality that could be generated by the proposed rock quarry is a health concern for my children. I believe they have the right to grow up in a safe, clean environment and I believe the formation of a rock quarry in the middle of our community would negatively impact the safety and cleanliness of the the air here.

As a citizen with a right to protect my safety, health, and livelihood and that of my family, I adamantly oppose this quarry. I respectfully ask that an informal public hearing take place to discuss these and other issues. I also request that a formal courtroom hearing be granted so that further evidence may be presented to the Land Reclamation Board. Thank you for your consideration.
