

Any water user with a water source and the equipment necessary to withdraw or divert 100,000 gallons or more per day (70 gallons per minute) from any stream, river, lake, well, spring or other water source is considered a major water user in Missouri and required to report their withdrawal annually.

Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Water Resources staff will be on hand from 12:30 p.m. to 2 p.m.



- At 12:30 p.m., Water Resources staff will give a presentation explaining the history and reporting requirements of Missouri's Major Water Users Law.
- Following the presentation, Water Resources staff will be available to answer questions about water use registration and reporting.
- This event is intended to educate sister agencies about Major Water User requirements so they can be better informed to answer or direct questions they receive from the public.
