

The Quadrants of the DNR logo

Upper left: the yellow quadrant features a bird passing in front of the sun, symbolizing the protection of our clean air for the survival of all, and the protection and use of renewable energy sources, such as the sun and wind.

Upper right: the blue quadrant contains a graphic comprising three horizontal, wavy lines. Each stands for, respectively, water quality, water protection and abundant water resources.

Lower right: the green quadrant depicts a leaf, symbolic of our state parks, as well as our efforts to ensure a healthy, growing environment in Missouri for the natural, historic and agricultural interests of the state and its citizens.

Lower left: the brown quadrant represents the soils and geology of the state, upon which the industry and commerce of Missouri depend. A microscope symbolizes the technical aspect of this responsibility. Testing, surveying, studying, sampling and monitoring depend on the best in technology, and best engineers and scientists to apply it.
