

Satellite Accumulation Regulation Summary



OPTION ONE - FEDERAL	OPTION TWO - STATE
Allows up to 55 gallons total of all waste streams in an area-40 CFR 262.34(c) (Note: volume limit, no time limit)	Allows up to 55 gallons of each waste stream in an area-10 CSR 25-5.262(2)(C)3 (Note: volume and time limit)
Allows multiple containers of each wastestream (federal interpretation)	Allows only one container per waste stream-(MO codified its interpretation)-10 CSR 25-5.262(2)(C)3.B

	Mark each container with its beginning date of accumulation -10 CSR 25-5.262(2)(C)3.C
	Container stored in a satellite area for more than one year must be removed within three calendar days if any one of the following occurs: 1. One year has passed since the accumulation start date 2. The container is full, OR 3. The container has reached its volume limit-10 CSR 25-5.262(2)(C)3.D.(I)(II) and (III)
<i>Remove the excess of 55 gallons (or 1 quart of acute hazardous waste) within three days or comply with the 90-day area or 180-day area regulations, as appropriate-262.34(c)(2)</i>	Containers of hazardous waste removed from the satellite accumulation area must be taken to the generator storage area, shipped offsite for proper hazardous waste management, or managed in accordance with an approved hazardous waste permit or certification at the site-10 CSR 25-5.262(2)(C)3.E
May start a new container during the 3 day excess storage period if meeting all other requirements above-Federal guidance	May start a new container during the 3 day excess storage period if meeting all other requirements above-10 CSR 25-5.262(2)(C)3.E
