Membership Composition

The director of the Department of Transportation or his/her designee and eight representatives appointed by the director of the Department of Natural Resources (three representatives of the limestone quarrying industry, one representative of the clay mining industry, one representative of the sandstone mining industry, one representative of the sand and gravel mining industry, one representative of the barite mining industry, and one representative of the granite mining industry). The director of the Department of Natural Resources or his/her designee acts as chairperson of the Council.

Terms

The director of the Department of Transportation or his/her designee serves indefinitely. The eight industry members serve for terms of three years. Any industry member may be reappointed, and all reappointments are for terms of three years.

Political Affiliation

Statute does not address this issue.

Compensation

All members are to be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred during the performance of their official duties in accordance with the reimbursement policy set by the director of the Department of Natural Resources. Reimbursements are to be paid from fees collected under 256.700 RSMo.

Geographic Consideration

Statute does not address this issue; however, all members shall be residents of Missouri.

Responsibilities of the Commission/Members

The Council shall (1) annually review with the state geologist the income received and expenditures made under sections 256.700 and 256.705 RSMo, (2) consider all information and advise the director of the Department of Natural Resources in determining the method and amount of fees to be assessed, (3) represent the best interests of the Missouri mining industry, and (4) serve in an advisory capacity in all matters pertaining to the administration of sections 256.700 and 256.710 RSMo.
