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Missouri Air Conservation Commission
Will Hold Public Hearing

The Missouri Air Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, March 29, 2018 beginning at 9 a.m. at the Elm Street Conference Center, 1730 East Elm Street, Lower Level, Bennett Springs Conference Room, Jefferson City, Missouri. The commission will hear testimony related to the following proposed action(s):

1. 10 CSR 10-2.310 (rescission) Control of Emissions From the Application of Automotive Underbody Deadeners

This rule is no longer necessary because the only source subject to this rule ceased operation about 30 years ago.

2. 10 CSR 10-2.360 (rescission) Control of Emissions From Bakery Ovens

This rule is no longer necessary because the only source subject to this rule ceased operation over 15 years ago.

3. 10 CSR 10-3.160 (rescission) Restriction of Emission of Fluorides From Diammonium Phosphate Fertilizer Production

This rule is no longer necessary because the last source subject to this rule dismantled their fertilizer production equipment over 10 years ago.

4. 10 CSR 10-5.120 (rescission) Information on Sales of Fuels to be Provided and Maintained

This is an outdated rule because the information required by this rule is no longer necessary due to modern U.S. Clean Air Act requirements and other federal and state regulations that control emissions.

5. 10 CSR 10-5.130 (rescission) Certain Coals to be Washed

This is an outdated rule because the requirements in this rule are no longer necessary due to modern U.S. Clean Air Act requirements and other federal and state regulations that control emissions.

6. 10 CSR 10-5.450 (rescission) Control of VOC Emissions from Traffic Coatings

A later federal requirement is duplicative of the substantive requirement in this rule. Therefore, the state rule is no longer necessary, and is being proposed for rescission.

7. 10 CSR 10-6.100 (rescission) Alternate Emission Limits

This is a proposed rescission of an obsolete rule. This rule was originally established in 1982, and was never approved into Missouri's State Implementation Plan (SIP).

8. 10 CSR 10-6.350 (rescission) Emission Limitations and Emissions Trading of Oxides of Nitrogen

9. 10 CSR 10-6.360 (rescission) Control of NO_x Emissions From Electric Generating Units and Non-Electric Generating Boilers

These rules are being proposed for rescission because they have been superseded by the federal Cross-State Air Pollution Rule (CSAPR). The CSAPR ozone season trading rule limitations are more restrictive than the state NO_x rules.

If the commission adopts the action(s), it will be the department's intention to submit the action(s) to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to be removed from Missouri's State Implementation Plan or other applicable federal plans.

Documents for the above item(s) will be available for review at the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Air Pollution Control Program, 1659 Elm Street, Jefferson City, (573) 751-4817 and in the Public Notices section of the program web site www.dnr.mo.gov/env/apcp/public-notices.htm. This information will be available at least 30 days prior to the public hearing date.
