I took photographs of the site on January 16, 2020, and it was clear when compared to Googled earlier photographic information that their was wooden façade type signs that created the town out of a cluster of metal buildings. The wooden signage had been removed hauled off per Mr. Jordan. Additionally, Mr. Jordan stated that a small portable building that had been built in the style of a log cabin had been sold and hauled away by the new owner after an auction took place some years ago. The materials open burned per Mr. Jordan included yard wastes such as brush that was burned to clean up the site. The various buildings on site are available for sale or lease, since these buildings are no longer used as part of an antiques and eatery business.

Mr. Jordan also stated that a vehicle fire also occurred on the day of his fire and was responded to by the local fire department. Mr. Jordan stated that the vehicle fire caused a lot more smoke than the multiple piles of material he open burned on the property. He also said that both the Phelps County Sheriff's Department and the Fire Department had visited his area to make sure that his fire was a separate and safe issue when they were dealing with the vehicle fire but they had not stopped to talk to him. For this reason, he did not believe that there was a problem with the size or scope of his open burning.
