I had difficulty understanding the complainant on my phone, but I gather someone is piling debris, including tires, at the end of Mack Street in Homestown, Missouri, and setting it on fire. I think the caller's name was Willie. His number is 573-379-6736. I think his adult granddaughter was helping him place the call. The fire is not currently burning, but it seems to be an ongoing issue.

**Comments** At the time of this investigation, no open burning was observed. Some tires were noted in the backyard of the residence. I left my business card in the door and I was reached by telephone by Mayor Melvin Mackland who stated that he was aware of the prohibition against open burning of tires. The Mayor stated that the tires were still on the rims as he had just removed them from his car.
