



Missouri Statutory Requirement

- 536.175 RSMo became effective on August 28, 2013
- Requires the periodic review of all agency rules
- DNR is responsible for reviewing all of its rules, of which there are approximately one hundred air rules
- Review process begins no later than July 1, 2016
- JCAR publishes notification in the Missouri Register
- Comments accepted for 60 days
- Agency provides report

Workgroup

- Air Program Advisory Forum members offer to help
- Kick-off conference call in August of 2013 results in the formation of a workgroup
- Utilization of Basecamp was proposed
- **Workgroup goal:** provide early input on air rules so that the majority of the workload takes place over the years and in advance of the 2016 due date

How to Review

- Identify obsolete rules or parts of rules due to more advanced technology
- Identify overly burdensome rules or parts of rules
- Identify rules with extremely old compliance dates
- Identify rules that duplicate/overlap other rules
- Identify rules that affect small business
- Point out where an alternate rule is more feasible
- Identify any errors in rules that need correction

Review Update

- Rules unit has reviewed 48 rules
 - Identified 4 rules for rescission
 - Identified over a dozen amendments
- SIP unit assisted with determining rules relied on in the SIP
- Ongoing research of approximately a dozen rules

Review Update

- Workgroup members have provided input through Basecamp on:
 - Opacity rule (6.220)
 - Traffic coatings rule (5.450)
 - Aerospace rules (2.205/5.295)
 - KC surface coating rule (2.230)
- Draft of SO₂ rule is coming soon

 - Discussion threads (messages)
