I spoke with Mr. Pool November 19 and he admitted that he burned demolition waste from a basement remodel project. 5. The burning on this property created a public nuisance. A Notice of Violation was issued for these.

<p>Comments On November 5, 2012, the KCRO received an e-mail from the Missouri Division of Fire Safety (DFS). DFS responded to this address on November 4 and observed the following items had burned: workshop/storage structure, tire stacked by the building electrical breaker boxes, small engine and auto parts, large speakers and tools including cutting torch equipment. DFS also found a cold burn pile about 100 yards from the burned structure. Burned items in the pile included asphalt shingles, pieces of siding, railroad ties, paint cans, suspected asbestos containing material and at least 100 burned tires.</p> <p>A Notice of Violation was issued to the property owner.</p> <p>Comp. No. 13842 Comp. Info. Mark Fechtig with the Missouri Division of Fire Safety was contacted on Sunday morning November 4, 2012, about a structure fire. While there, he found a burn pile in the ditch. The burn pile was not connected with the structure fire and had been out for some time.</p> <p>The structure where the fire occurred on Sunday was full of junk with a lot of auto parts and small engines and parts and other items in it. Several tires burned that were stacked around the structure as well.</p> <p>The property belongs to Barry Dean Pilant, white, male; DOB:12-30-1960, listed phone number of 816-560-3157. The address where this occurred is 36124 Highway T, Camden, MO. The address on his driver's license is 100 S. Creason St., Orrick MO. Mr. Fechtig could not locate him on the day of the fire. Mr. Fechtig made a couple of Google Earth maps showing the locations and he provided the pictures he took.</p>

<p>Comments It has been determined that construction or demolition wastes were disposed of by open burning. Open burning of such materials is a violation of Missouri Regulation 10 CSR 10-6.045, Open Burning Requirements. A Notice of Violation is being issued.</p> <p>Comp. No. 13849 Comp. Info. Illegal burning. The individual residing at 36505 State Highway N, Garden City, MO was planning to burn his large, 2-story barn and was advised by the local fire protection district to talk with DNR. The individual (whom the fire chief described as generally belligerent) refused. The individual tore down his barn and burned the debris on Friday night, November 2. The individual is located just outside of Garden City, and the FPD received several complaints/concerns regarding the fire. When the local sheriff and others went to investigate, he was met at the property boundary by several individuals who were belligerent and seemingly intoxicated. No permission was granted to anyone to enter the property.</p> <p>The fire chief for the Garden City FPD went to investigate the following morning, and found the barn still burning. He knocked on the door, but received no response (despite multiple vehicles in the driveway).</p>

Comments	On November 12, 2012, Wood Heights Fire Department (WHFD) responded to an alarm at this residence. Upon arrival, they observed the following items burning: fiberglass camper shell, drywall, stucco, insulation and tires. Additionally, the wire remnants of furniture and demolition debris were burned. Resident was warned by WHFD last year for burning materials. Disposal of these items by open burning is a violation of Missouri Regulation 10 CSR 10-6.045 Open Burning Requirements.								
	In May, 2007, the KCRO issued a Notice of Violation to Paul Glenn for failure to comply with asbestos inspection and notification requirements. KCRO records show that, on May 9, 1997, Mr. Glenn was advised not to dump trade waste including demolition waste on his property, and that burning trade waste and demolition waste including asbestos is a violation of air pollution regulations and solid waste law.

On 11/28/12, the planers weren't up to production which could have caused trouble with the stack. Maintenance activities have been ongoing all week with the large stack with starting up and shutting down several times, all the while adjusting the temperature. Another factor is when the ambient temperature is below 32 degrees, more smoke is observed during startup in the mornings. The warmer the temperature, will see less smoke. A lot of moisture comes out of the wood also, is not always smoke. Maintenance was also being performed on the boiler stack, as a shaft had twisted off and was being repaired. At the time of investigation the boiler stack was showing variable smoke amounts being emitted into the atmosphere from the maintenance activities with startup and shutdown. The large shavings cyclone stack was shut down as mentioned above. The result of the large plume observed was a result of maintenance activities and the planers in the shavings operations were not up to production on 11/28, which resulted in an inconsistent rate of feed into the cyclone stack, which is when fluctuations occur.</p>
