	Before arriving on site I checked with Rachel Rush of WP to see if there was a land disturbance permit for this facility. There is. She joined me on my investigation.							
	We arrived on site at 10:45 a.m. on May 3, 2016. Upon arrival, the ground was sufficiently wetted, and there were no visible emissions. Heavy machinery was driving throughout the property, and they were not kicking up much dust. I spoke with Kelly Lynch of A.L. Huber about the concern. He stated that they had some issues with dust before we had a lot of rain. I explained to him the regulation, and Rachel talked to him about the requirements of the land disturbance permit. He acknowledged that he was aware of the requirements. They log watering and rain events on site. I advised him to watch the amount of dust being generated because there are residences directly across the street to the north, and they will call us if there is an ongoing issue. He agreed. There were no violations at the time of the inspection.

Concern No.	27064	Concern Info	CP states that neighbor operates Day Tree service company. Mr. Day routinely burns large piles of wood chips that he generates from his business. The burning occurs about once a month and will last for about a week at a time. The pile of debris will cover an area of about 15 x 15 feet and about 6 feet tall. The pile will smolders producing heavy smoke that penetrates the CP's and surrounding neighbors homes.					
Comments	I told Mr. Day that since he was proactive and had not burned and won't until he receives his burn permit that I was going to send him a letter of warning.							
	On May 12, 2016, I responded to the above concern. Upon arrival to 16070 Winan Rd there was evidence of a pile of tree trunks and tree limbs that had not been burned. I went to the door of the residence/business and there was no one there. I left my card, the open burn regulation, the open burn fact sheet and a note to have Mr. Day call me.							
	On May 13, 2016, upon arrival to the regional office I had a voice mail from Mr. Day at 8:18 pm on May 12, 2016. I called Mr. Day at approximately 8:15 am on May 13, 2016, and discussed my reason for the visit. He told me that he talked to the local fire authorities about burning and they told him to not burn anymore until he fills out the open burn permit application and they would come out and look at the pile and approve it then the application would be sent to KCRO for our approval and issuance of the burn permit. I told him that that was correct and I was going to suggest that. Mr. Day will be going to get his burn permit application and not burn until he receives the permit.

The fax stated that the renters of the property at 901 N Main Street, Mr. Michael Sisler and Ms. Tabitha Sisler disposed of the following items by open burning: electrical wires, bed mattress springs, carpet, oil filters, and other wooden objects they couldn't identify. Mr. Sisler stated he was unaware of the open burning regulation and was advised by the owner, Leah Holcomb, to burn the items.

Ms. Holcomb has been warned many times about open burning according to the La Monte Police.

Photos are being sent to the department from the City of La Monte.

Comments An LOW will be issued to Ms. Sisler and Ms. Holcomb for violations of the open burning regulation.

I arrived on site and talked to Tabitha Sisler, who rents the property with Michael Sisler. Her story backed up the police incident reports. Leah Holcomb, the owner of the property, left a pile of construction and demolition waste in the back yard when the Sislers moved in. Instead of removing the waste, she told the Sislers to burn the pile. The Sislers burned the pile. The city had warned Ms. Holcomb at least twice previously to not burn prohibited items.

Ms. Holcomb denies ever being warned about burning at the property and said the pile just had vegetative waste and pallets inside the pile.

The burn pile appeared to contain construction and demolition waste, bed mattresses, carpet, oil filters, and many other objects. The size of the pile was about 15 yards x 10 yards long and 2 feet high.

Comments	An NOV will be issued for violations of the open burning regulation, including disposal of construction and demolition waste by open burning. I arrived at the property at 11 a.m. on June 1, 2016. I was unable to make contact with anyone at the site. A NOV was issued previously to Mr. Kurtz at the same location for burning construction and demolition waste from a house that was halfway torn down. When I arrived at the property this time, the house was no longer there and there were signs that it had recently been torn down. There was also a roll off dumpster on the property that was empty. I also observed a burn pile that had construction and demolition waste inside it. The pile was about 10ft x 15ft x 4ft and was located about 75 yards from the neighbor's house. I called Mr. Kurtz and left him a message on June 1, 2016. Mr. Kurtz did not return my phone call.

Concern No. 27839 **Concern Info** Person (male) allegedly burning at his residential address in Richmond, MO. Materials include insulation and other materials not intrinsically meant to be burned but from commercial properties. Concerned that this is unpermitted due to scope of materials and methodology of disposal. Ray County Planning and Zoning person stated she would send photographs over via email and provided work email address for same. Ms. Wolfe asked to be kept informed of the status of the inspection. Sent an email containing her information and more photographs than those attached - forwarded to Michael Cunningham, Air Pollution Control, Kansas City Regional Office, Unit Chief.

Comments LOW issued for burning of trade waste on the property.

I emailed with Stacy Wolfe of Ray County Planning and Zoning on June 7 - 8 about the situation. She said a building inspector had been out, but that the situation was continuing. She said that the CP had been into her office and stated that they had moved the burn pile to the RP's mother's house, which was a few houses south. We scheduled to meet on June 9 at 9:30 a.m.

On June 9, 2016, Seth Norcross and I met Ray County Building Inspector Larry Eastley at the Ray County Courthouse in Richmond, MO, at 9:30 a.m. We talked a little about the situation. We learned that Mr. Eastley had not made contact with the responsible party yet, but he had a lot of contact with the CP, Tom Harmon, and had taken photographs from his property.

We proceeded to Mr. Harmon's property to look at the burn pile from his property first. He told us that the Roes had rented a back-hoe and had hauled some of the burnt debris off, but he wasn't sure where they took it. He also told us that it appeared they are trying to run a salvage operation, as people will drop things off, and Mr. Roe will burn it or haul it away later. It was apparent that the burning of prohibited items was occurring. The pile was within 200 yards from Mr. Harmon's property and was full of cardboard, metal, trash, and other debris. The debris that can be seen in Mr. Eastley's photos that were taken on May 26 2016, had been cleaned up. Mr. Harmon told us that he thought the RP and his brother were burning at their mother's property, but you couldn't see it from the road because it was on top of a high spot in the yard. Mr. Harmon asked me to keep him updated on the progress.

We proceeded to Mr. Roe's property. We knocked on the door, and his wife, Rebecca Roe, answered. She showed us to the burn pile. She stated that her husband will sort through what is brought to the property, and what "cannot be burned" they take to a salvage or sell. We explained to her that under the regulation, everything we could see in that pile were prohibited items. I explained that in Ray county, they can burn vegetative waste, but they must obtain a burn permit and keep the pile 200 yards away from the nearest occupied structure that was not their own. Mrs. Roe stated that they were issued a burn permit that was good for a year (when I returned to the office, I looked up this permit: FY16-1090 issued 3/15/2016, expires 3/15/2017). I told her that the burn permit says in the conditions that only vegetative waste can be burned. She stated that they do have a brush pile they burn sometimes, and I told her that they should be sure it is located on the other end of their property where they would be closer to the 200 yard rule. I asked her to have her husband call me so I could discuss the regulation with him as well and told her that the pile would need to be cleaned up. We asked if they were burning anywhere else, and she said no, this was their only pile.

When we left the property, we drove by the mother's property. A brush pile could be seen from the road. We did not enter the property. A letter of warning will be issued for burning prohibited items, including trade waste, on the property.

Sheriff called as a precaution as the RP was obviously impaired. This residence has been visited and warned in the past (I was there before). Foam application applied. Pictures are attached. DNR should be informed in my opinion. -Lee

Comments There is no proof that Mr. Small III burned the regulated waste; therefore, a letter of warning will be issued requiring him to clean up and properly dispose of all waste at a permitted landfill and provide receipts.

On June 14, 2016, I along with Corey Whiteaker and Cass County Sheriff deputy escort, responded to the above concern. Upon arrival to 24101 189th Street, the property had a partial wooden fence and a locked gate. Corey and I could not see the burn pile. The deputy told us that the property had been cleaned up and the gate and fence were new since the last time he was at the property. We approached the residence and knocked on the door; the deputy saw someone in the house, but that person did not answer the door. I placed my card under the magnet that was on the front door with a note that asked to be called.

We left the residence and we followed the deputy around the perimeter of the property in our vehicles. We stopped along side the road; he showed us the approximate location of the burn pile, and trees were obstructing our view. We proceeded to the southern most boundary of the property, which were hay fields, but there was no access to the back side of the residence.

The deputy located the name of another sibling, Anna (Small) Vandeveld, and provided us with her contact information. On our way back from the concern, we stopped by Ms. Vandeveld's residence and left my card with a note to call me.

On June 15, 2016, Ms. Vandeveld called, and I explained to her what had happened at the residence and that I was needing her brother's contact information. She told me that her father died, that the property has been in probate, and no one is allowed on the premises. She told me that John has gone out there on the weekends because of people "staying there" and trashing the place and dumping stuff on the property. She also told me that the siblings are not close with the family. I told her that if she did contact her brother that he needs to call me so I can talk to him about the burning. She told me she would try to get in touch with him.

On June 16, 2016, Ms. Vandeveld called and said that she spoke to her brother, James, about the burn that happened on the property. He told her that he did not do the burning. She also told me that she was going out to the property this weekend to look at the property and look at the burn pile. I asked her to call me on Monday the 20th after she goes out there, and I also asked her if she would then give me permission to get on the property so I can document and finish my inspection/investigation on this concern. She said that she would call on Monday.

On June 17, 2016, John James Small III called. I told him about the concern and asked if he burned or knew who burned the waste on the property. He told me that he had burned in the past, but he did not burn the waste pile. He also told me that they dug a pond, but it never held water so they were using that to dump stuff in. I explained that would be a solid waste issue and they need to remove it, but not until I get out there to complete my investigation. He told me that they would not remove anything. I asked if I had his permission to get on the property and he said yes. I told him that his sister was supposed to call me on Monday with her approval to get on the property as well. He said that he could meet me out there next week. I told him that if he is upfront and honest with me, a letter of warning will be issued, but if any of the burned debris is removed or if he is not honest with me, a notice of violation will be issued. He told me he understood and he told me again that he would not remove anything.

On June 24, 2016, I returned to the property with a sheriff deputy and met Mr. Small. We walked back to the burn site, which was a dug out pond.

Mr. Bechtold has allowed this place to become a carcinogenic toxic waste dump. They are storing a huge unconfined pile of dry coal fly ash dust the size of a small mountain less than 75 feet from our property. The coal dust toxins constantly blows on us. We cannot even go outside anymore it's so bad. Our yard, patio, and house, even on the inside is always covered in black dust. In addition to being toxic and carcinogenic, the coal dust is EXTREMELY flammable. My husband has tried three times in the past couple months to burn some leaves and sticks and every time we end up having a gigantic fire burning out of control. This is even when there is no wind. Also if the wind is blowing in the opposite direction of the toxic waste dump, the fire ALWAYS makes a blazing out of control trail of fire in the direction of their toxic dump. When we try to put these fires out with water, the fire only gets bigger! One time we had to call the fire department. And one time my husband got his leg burnt and it took it forever to heal, probably because of the coal ash. It is getting ridiculous. The highway dept toxic waste dump also has four or five gigantic chemical tanks that they store right next to the coal ash. These chemical tanks are less than 60 feet from our property. One weekend, I think this past November we could smell a horrible bleach or chlorine-like chemical smell coming from them that was so strong I almost had to go to the ER with a severe migraine and my eyes burning. This went on from Friday-the following Monday morning when it finally quit. They also keep their coal dust right next to a stream which a few years ago used to be real clear and sparkling. Now it's nasty and dark and murky and it stinks. It's repugnant to say the least. This now nasty toxic stream flows down to a ditch along Hwy. 34 where it just flows along side the highway when it rains. (Full concern attached.)

Comments

The investigation took place on May 5, 2016 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:07 p.m. The wind was from the North at 15 mph. No visible dust emissions were observed leaving the property. The tanks observed on site included empty tanks for salt brine solution used for winter road application and a 1500 gallon salt brine tank with unused brine solution still contained. There were three tanks for MC-30, which is a priming oil used to prepare dusty roads for paving. HFE-150 is also kept on site in a 1000 gallon portable Duratank and in an oil truck. HFE-150 is an anionic medium set asphalt emulsion. HFE-150 is used for surface treatments and open and dense graded cold constructed asphalt pavements (CCAP). For instance, HFE-150 may be used for pothole repair. Above ground fuel storage tanks are also present in a containment on site: the larger 10-15,000 gallon tank is for on-road diesel and the smaller 1000 gallon tank contains unleaded gasoline. There is a storage pile of silica (clay, gravel, and sand) used as fill for laying pipe such as for drainage culvert pipes. There is chipped rock and salt under roof in an open ended barn. There is a pile of fly ash on site that is used with the chipped rock and salt for road application in the winter. The fly ash was obtained from Southeast Missouri State University during the period when the university's steam producing boiler plant was still burning coal as fuel. Fly ash from universities that burn coal for fuel is not regulated as a Subtitle D "special waste" under the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). The fly ash pile appeared to have been located on site for some time and had compacted. Mulch had been applied to the western edge for wind erosion control. A small pile of waste passenger tires were stored on site as was a pile of waste brick from Pavestone, LLC. in Scott City. The waste brick could be used for water erosion control as it is clean fill having been manufactured in a ready mixed cement block and brick plant in Scott City. The passenger tires are picked up when left along roads in Cape Girardeau county. There is a wet weather drainage ditch around the property that flows around the property from Highway 72 to Highway 34.

I want to sell my property now to supplement my retirement, but this constant pollution makes that increasingly difficult. While I am not an attorney, I believe that this business is violating 10 CSR 10-6.170: Restriction of Particulate Matter to the Ambient Air Beyond the Premises of Origin. (entire concern contents is attached).					
Comments	I investigated Wakes Feed and Fertilizer on May 4, 2016 and spoke with the mill manager of the facility. I observed a truck unloading feed and observed very little particulate in the air. At one point there was a bit more in the air, but it only lasted seconds. He stated that they have the drivers leave the tops of the trailers closed during unloading as to minimize feed in the air. He also mentioned that a few months ago they installed lids on the bins as they are all ventilated now. At the time of investigation, maintenance was performing some repairs on the bins. The manager spoke with maintenance during the visit and they determined that they could make boots/shrouds from an old tarp for the two down spouts that are used. There is a cyclone on the pellet mill that he stated is cleaned every morning with a chimney sweep. He said the mill is normally shut down for a few days at a time also. It was running at the time of investigation, but hadn't been since last Friday. Wakes average throughput is around 685 tons/month. During the visit, most operations were being performed and there was little to no particulate in the air. See the below photos. The manager stated that they try to make repairs as they occur or are observed. No further investigation on this concern at this time.

The facility operates under Permit #MO-0134201.</p> <p>On May 13, 2016 at 9:45 A.M., I arrived at Hansen's Wood and Green Waste Facility near Reed's Spring. Upon arrival, I noted that there was not a noticeable odor emanating from Hansen's Facility. After arriving to the facility, I called Mr. Mike Walker, Representative of Hansen's Facility, and he was at a meeting in Springfield and was not able to be on-site; however, he gave me permission to inspect the property.</p> <p>During our phone conversation, I told Mr. Walker that I was responding to a concern about odors emanating from Hansen's Facility, and potential water runoff from the property. He stated that the facility has a Solid Waste permit to receive food waste. The facility receives two loads per week of produce food waste from Wal-Mart. The loads arrive at the facility on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The food waste is added to the shredded tree compost. The investigation took place on Friday, one day after the last load arrived, and I observed that the compost piles were hot enough to be discharging vapors from the decomposition of organic matter.</p> <p>During the investigation, I observed that the permittee's Best Management practices were being implemented, and that the facility had completed recommendations from the last inspection report from June 29, 2015. The silt socks were in good condition, and rip rap had been added to the outfall. There was no signs of sedimentation leaving the property, or entering the creek. The entire facility has a grass buffer around the compost piles, with silt socks before the sedimentation basin, which have also helped to prevent runoff.</p> <p>After the investigation, I noticed a slight odor of compost and food waste at the intersection of 160/248 and 13. The odor became more noticeable with winds from the South. The facility was in compliance with its permit conditions and Water Quality Standards of the State of Missouri at the time of investigation. I told Mr. Mike Walker to make sure that the DMR for the first quarter of 2016 had been submitted, as I did not see it in the facility's paper file.</p>
