

Temporary/Pilot Plant Permit

Regulated Activities:	Construction of a temporary installation or pilot plant with a potential to emit of less than 100 tons of each pollutant per year
Fees:	\$250 filing \$75 per hour review
Required Documents:	Two copies of the completed application form
Length of Permit:	Temporary permits are valid for a period not longer than two years from the date of issuance, dependent upon the type of activity
Processing Time:	Temporary permits are issued within 30 days of receipt of a complete application. If additional technical information is requested during the permit review, the time spent by the applicant preparing this information is not included in the 30 days.
Pre-application Meetings	None are required.
Public Participation:	This is not required.
