Prior to the inspection, an in-person conversation to place between the concerned party and I, in which we clarified that the source of the concern was not Western Ready Mix, but Eastern Missouri Concrete located on Wilmer Road. Mr. Augustine showed me a photograph on his phone taken at his job and towards the source location of a dust he and showed a video of dust originating from the plant.

I then drove to the source location and received permission from an MFA (located adjacent to the location) representative, Mr. Phil Brakensiek, to park their property and observe Eastern Missouri Concrete's location. During this conversation, I asked Mr. Brakensiek whether he observed any excessive dust from the facility and he stated that he noticed no issues with their next-door neighbor. It is notable to mention that MFA and Eastern Missouri Concrete share a border separated by a barbed wire fence, but with an opening which allows people to freely walk between the two businesses if needed.

I parked and walked over to the north-western side of the property to see if I could watch loading of concrete within the redi-mix trucks from the property. After sitting for a few minutes towards the property, one of the Eastern Missouri Concrete employees noticed me and made a comment on whether I was watching the facility. I took the opportunity to introduce myself and my reason for being there. The employee led me to the facility's office and introduced me to Charlie, the facility's manager.

We first discussed plant operations within the office and Mr. Dees provided me with a tour of facility operations. In the end, I decided to conduct a routine air pollution source inspection.

I left a message 2:58pm July 3rd with the concerned party as a follow-up to the concern and mentioned that I conducted a routine air pollution source inspection, had not observed excessive fugitive particulate matter, but that I intended to issue a Letter of Warning to the facility for other reasons related to their operations.
