	36343		Concern Info Air quality in communities around the Ford Motor Plant. I first contacted the MODNR in 2015 regarding a acetone-type odor around the Pleasant Valley area. It was traced to the Ford Motor Plant in Claycomo. A Ford representative stated it was due to a "bio organism" located in some of the their smokestacks and they would be scrubbing said smokestacks over their Christmas shutdown. After the first of the year (2016) the odor dissipated and all seemed well...until late summer of 2017 when the same acetone-type smell again became airborne. This time, when Ford was contacted, they said the smell was coming from their "truck paint sludge pit." Whatever the source was, within time it again seemed to dissipate. Now, the obnoxious odor is back...but nobody seems to have resolution for it. I have heard that it is "harmless" yet I'm not certain how factual that statement can be when different explanations have been offered for the source. I personally have contacted your agency- first hearing from a Ciara Oehring in 2015 who was extremely helpful in providing information and seemed to have assisted in the "first" resolution of the odor. This last event when I called (August 2018) I received a phone message from Jake (from MODNR) on Sept 20 that my complaint was investigated but "no issue was detected but we have contacted Ford who is aware of my concern and hopefully they will have it resolved soon." I am not certain how many visits were made to the area for testing but there is absolutely no way- if multiple visits were made at different times of the day/night, that "no odor" would be detected! Of course weather will play a part in the direction the odor is carried, and the odor seems strongest in mid evening and early morning and yes, strong on weekends too. (I will be honest and say it is not 7 days a week...and I can't really "nail down" that it is always on specific days) but multiple visits must be made, at varying times, to make certain your tests are valid. I have personally heard and read of complaints as far west as Gladstone and northern Liberty (by Libe Hospital). Fox4 News did a piece in early September and also much frustration has been compiled on Nextdoor.com. and other social media sites. This odor can become so obtrusive at times that it literally takes your breath away when encountered! Again, just this past Monday evening 10/29 @ about 9pm, I was forced to close my windows in my home in Pleasant Valley due to the odor.

I have had no complaints regarding this issue since the DNR order was issued and since that time the trade waste from Hilltop Tree Service (HTS) has grown into a massive accumulation covering an estimated 1/2 acre that is about 20 ft in height and located directly adjacent to and 50' from county road 292. Comments I began investigating this environmental concern on the afternoon of October 18, 2018, but I did not get to observe the plant in production for long enough to make a final determination. I returned on October 22, 2018, in the early afternoon and was able to observe the plant in operation producing hot asphalt. During this second visit to the area, I conducted a Method 9---Visual Determination of the Opacity of Emissions From Stationary Sources (see Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 60 Appendix A). The Method 9 was conducted until the hot drum mix asphalt batch plant was shut down. It appeared that a sufficient amount of time had passed since the last tractor trailer had been loaded to fill the asphalt silo. The result of the Method 9 was an average of just over 47% opacity. The asphalt plant is limited to 20% by Title 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart I---Standards of Performance for Hot Mix Asphalt Facilities. Next on October 22, 2018, I spoke with Mr. Scott Foster at Robertson Asphalt. Mr. Foster is The Plant Manager. I discussed the special conditions of the asphalt plant's air construction permit (see permit number 042016-012). I also discussed briefly the open burning regulations as they apply to businesses. I mentioned that Title 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart OOO---Standards of Performance for Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants might apply to any crusher used for crushing recycled asphalt paving containing nonmetallic mineral(s) aggregates at this site. Additionally, I briefly discussed that it appeared that the plant's baghouse might need repair and I discussed that the bags might need replacement or it might be something more serious. I also told Mr. Scott Foster that they would be required to make repairs to return to compliance and that I would send out a Letter of Warning with a deadline for addressing the problem.

A violation of 10 CSR 10-6.070 Maximum Achievable Control Technology Regulations adopting by reference Title 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart I---Standards of Performance for Hot Mix Asphalt Facilities was observed.

The gin shuts down for a meal and a cleaning hour period during each of the two twelve hour daily shifts. Most gin maintenance and repair occurs in the non-ginning part of the year. The weather was mostly sunny, temperatures were in the low to mid fifty degree range, wind was from the NNE. at 6 miles per hour, and the humidity was in the range of 61 to 47 percent. While Farmers Storage did have some visible emissions, these emissions seemed normal for the facility and were not observed crossing property lines. Farmers Storage is a grain elevator and was receiving grain by truck at the time of my investigation. The facility has a permanent storage capacity of 1.2 million bushels of grain (e.g. rice). The elevator had been receiving and drying rice during the harvest season. I spoke with Mr. Jeff Wright, Operating Manager, who stated that the facility was be rescreening the dryer next year. The dryer has screens that catch the rice hulls to keep them from being released from the dryer. These rice hulls have to be regularly removed from the dryer, so that the dryer does not catch fire. A rice hull stock pile was located on the parking lot. The rice hulls are generated from the rice receiving, handling, and drying operations at the grain elevator and are a biodegradable waste product. Dust emissions were observed being generated from a bin vent and from an elevator leg during this investigation; but these visible emissions were observed to be staying on Farmers Storage property. Farmers Storage, Inc. typically will achieve full storage capacity once during harvest season and then load out when the market is conducive to rice sales. This is not the case for grain elevators located on a navigable river (e.g. the Mississippi River) where the elevator receives grain (usually by truck) and ships grain (by barge on the river) throughout the calendar year.

AB Mauri relocated its North American headquarters from the County to Cortex, and occupies a 23,000 square-foot office in the @42 complex. Besides administrative offices, the space includes a state of the art test kitchen, chemistry labs and a fermentation facility now under construction.</p> <p>Industrial operations that emit smoke and particulates typically have scrubbers in the smoke stacks to filter the emissions before being discharged into the air and surrounding neighborhood.
