He stated the removal contractor didn't follow any EPA or OSHA guidelines or procedure for removal - they didn't use any type of enclosure or precautions. He stated they put the material in 55-gallon drums and just threw it in the dumpster and it wasn't wrapped in plastic. Caller said the Director had told him there was 2% asbestos in the flooring.</p> <p>Caller said he and another guy had to clean up the classrooms after the floor tile was removed, and felt they were exposed that time. They are a sub of AL Huber (Overland Park, KS). AL Huber is the general contractor for J Rieger & Co distillery which is expanding their operations and office space at this building.</p> <p>Acme Flooring was sanding a 10,000 square foot floor from a building built in 1901 located at 2700 Guinotte Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri. CP stated that he used four lead testing sticks on areas of the flooring that had been painted. Some results were positive for lead-based paint. He is also concerned about exposure to creosote because he stated that the floors were creosote soaked wood floors under the painted layers. CP stated that approximately 30 bags of waste from sanding the floor were placed in a dumpster. Two bags are still on site and he has two bags of waste from when they took back his truck when he was fired (around May 8th). He believes that they are still sanding the remaining floor. Mr. Hamilton estimated that he sanded 7,000 sq feet in the two weeks he worked there. There are/were multiple other trades people working at the building while the sanding was occurring (sheet rock/window installers, plumbers, electricians, etc).</p> <p>CP stated that Apex Environmental (14955 W. 101st Terrace, Lenexa) performed air sampling while he was working in a curtained area that they had set up but refused to provide him with the sampling results. Acme provided him a respirator but he has a full beard and he believes the pink cartridges in the respirator were wrong for the job he was doing. He is not in medical monitoring.</p> <p>CP boss is Robert Kenny and directed his work to continue even after he voiced concerns about exposure to lead-based paint. Ron Knoll (he is unsure of Ron's role) and Randy Hamilton (head of commercial sales, also his father) were on site and aware of the conditions. I advised Mr. Hamilton to get his blood tested for lead but he stated that his doctor's office had refused to run the test through his insurance because it was a possible workman's comp issue. I suggested strongly that he get his blood tested regardless and maybe try the health department.</p>

CP called stating that Lafayette County condemned the restaurant and swimming pool at Holiday Lakes (now Sawmill Valley Country Club). CP stated the county demolished the building and pool this winter. The demolition materials are still present. CP stated that yellow paint has been observed leaving the materials and entering a nearby pond. The pond may discharge the Sni-a-Bar creek, but the CP was not certain. CP would like the Department to assess if the waterbody has been impacted.

Excerpt from WPC investigation:

"I visited the site on Monday 13th May. Upon arrival, I observed large piles of building rubble at on the left of Saw Mill Rd (site 1). It appeared that this was rubble from a building that had been demolished on site. The rubble had been collected into two discrete piles and appeared to have been partially burned. The material consisted of asphalt tiles, concrete blocks, wood, general plastic trash, glass and other building materials.

I then proceeded approximately 200feet north to the site of the old swimming pool (site 2). There were three more piles of building debris within 100 feet of each other. The piles consisted of fiberglass (old water slide), vegetation, building materials (wood and concrete) and some general plastic trash."

On May 30, 2019, a message was received from the CP stating the County had been out there for two days burning the pile and pushing material around the site.

One hundred micrometers are equivalent to 0.10 millimeters in length. Rice hulls do not meet the scale of the definition and are, therefore, not regulated as fugitive particulate matter by the applicable air regulation.

The rice hulls are received from the mill in Jonesboro and are transported to the Arbyrd location for storage and eventual reshipment by CPC Commodities in South Central Kentucky. According to Mr. Pedigo the only time any rice hull dust is released is at loading out for reshipment by truck and then only when it is very windy. Most of the time the rice hulls are unloaded and stored in the warehouse building.

The rule does give generators of fugitive emissions some room to operate by directing them to take reasonable measures to correct violations. Here is the wording in the regulation:</p> <p>(B) Should the director determine that noncompliance with subsection (3)(A) has occurred at a location, the director may require reasonable control measures, as may be necessary. These measures may include, but are not limited to, the following: 1. Revision of procedures involving construction, repair, cleaning, and demolition of buildings and their appurtenances that produce particulate matter emissions; 2. Paving or frequent cleaning of roads, driveways, and parking lots; 3. Application of dust-free surfaces; 4. Application of water; and 5. Planting and maintenance of vegetative ground cover.</p> <p>The company's vacuum bags may work as reasonable measures if they are operated correctly. I asked him to ensure that his employees are using the vacuum system correctly and that the workers must be cognizant of times that they are generating excessive dust. I asked about wet grinding which he stated won't work because the equipment is electric and spray down a brick wall before grinding won't work because the water will only impact the top layer of the mortar.</p> <p>Mr. Hamilton stated that they are done grinding on all of the buildings on Clemens in University City.
