I observed several trucks coming in and out of the facility. I met the Site Manager, Mr. Dough Werle (314-681-7062). I presented my credentials and explained the reason for my visit. Mr. Werle said the facility has been operating at this location (on 700 acres of land) since 1950. All blasting sites are located under ground and, therefore no dust is generated from the blasting operation. There was 1 primary and 2 secondary crushers and 30 conveyors and some aggregate piles located at the very west corner of the facility. It looked to me that migration of dust beyond the property line from the operations of the conveyors and aggregate piles which are stored nearby by the conveyors is unlikely due to the tall thick trees around the facility which can serve as barriers.

However, there was a 797 feet high (elevation from sea level) pile of "minus" gravel fines (size of 1/16 an inch or less) on site at the east side of the property identified by the caller as a source of migration of dust to her property. The site manager said that the pile is a byproduct of the crushing and sizing operations (see photo 1 and 2). This pile elevation is higher than the trees around it and the house of Ms. Cruse located at 2501 HWY F (google map shows the elevation at the roof level is 723 feet high). The google map elevation readings were provided by Mr. Werle.

I called Ms. Cruse (636-357-8407) and asked her if I can meet and talk to her. Ms. Cruse was not at home but let me go and see her property without her. I asked Mr. Werle to go with me. We drove about a mile and half from the quarry on Hwy F east and turned north on Rugged Acres Lane to get to the house. We observed the area around the house and the swimming pool area (photo 3). We observed two or three very tiny spots of black dust settled at the bottom of the swimming pool. At the time of inspection, it was not possible to determine where the dust in the swimming pool came from. However, Mr. Werle indicated the dust might be from his quarry.

At the conclusion of my visit, I encouraged him to talk to Ms. Cruse and other residents nearby. He told me: The facility will make sure that some of the pile is removed and stored at other locations in such a way that the trees around may serve as barriers. The facility will purchase an additional sprinkler system to water the piles of the byproduct. He also said he will meet Ms. Cruse to let her know the steps he is planning to take to address her concern.

On June 13, I called Ms. Cruse as a follow up. She told me the site manager and the owner of the quarry visited her house and discussed the steps the facility is planning to take to address her concern. Ms. Cruse told me she is happy that they came and the conversation she had with them went very well.
