During this second visit to the area, I conducted a Method 9---Visual Determination of the Opacity of Emissions From Stationary Sources (see Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 60 Appendix A). The Method 9 was conducted until the hot drum mix asphalt batch plant was shut down. It appeared that a sufficient amount of time had passed since the last tractor trailer had been loaded to fill the asphalt silo. The result of the Method 9 was an average of just over 47% opacity. The asphalt plant is limited to 20% by Title 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart I---Standards Performance for Hot Mix Asphalt Facilities. Next on October 22, 2018, I spoke with Mr. Scott Foster at Robertson Asphalt. Mr. Foster is The Plant Manager. I discussed the special conditions of the asphalt plant's air construction permit (see permit number 042016-012). I also discussed briefly the open burning regulations as they apply to businesses. I mentioned that Title 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart OOO---Standards of Performance for Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants might apply to any crusher used for crushing recycled asphalt paving containing nonmetallic mineral(s) aggregates at this site. Additionally, I briefly discussed that it appeared that the plant's baghouse might need repair and I discussed that the bags might need replacement or it might be something more serious. I also told Mr. Scott Foster that they would be required to make repairs to return to compliance and that I would send out a Letter of Warning with a deadline for addressing the problem.

A violation of 10 CSR 10-6.070 Maximum Achievable Control Technology Regulations adopting by reference Title 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart I---Standards of Performance for Hot Mix Asphalt Facilities was observed.

Comments I visited Marston in the morning from 10:28 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. The weather was mostly sunny, the temperature was in the low to mid 50's, and the wind was out of the NNE at 6 miles per hour. I alternated between viewing the property boundaries at Richardson Gin, Inc. (143-0040) and Farmer Storage, Inc. (143-0026). Emissions appeared normal for these two facilities. While both had some visible emissions the visible emissions were not observed leaving the facility properties. Farmer Storage was receiving grain trucks at the time of my observations and Richardson Gin was ginning cotton. Mr. Barry Richardson, Jr. Vice president of Richardson Gin, Inc. stated that the gin had processed about 10,300 bales of cotton so far for this ginning season. Mr. Richardson predicted about 9 or 10 weeks of ginning were left. The gin had started up on September 19, 2018, and had ginned 117 bales of cotton that day. No malfunctions had occurred so far this ginning season. The gin uses cyclones and screens as air pollution control devices. The screens are located on the lint cleaners. The cyclones are lined and most of them were worked on during the maintenance season. There are two banks of cyclones. The gin shuts down for a meal and a cleaning hour period during each of the two twelve hour daily shift. Most gin maintenance and repair occurs in the non-ginning part of the year. However, preventive maintenance and repair can occur daily during the meal/cleaning hour.

No violation was observed.

The weather was mostly sunny, temperatures were in the low to mid fifty degree range, wind was from the NNE. at 6 miles per hour, and the humidity was in the range of 61 to 47 percent. While Farmers Storage did have some visible emissions, these emissions seemed normal for the facility and were not observed crossing property lines. Farmers Storage is a grain elevator and was receiving grain by truck at the time of my investigation. The facility has a permanent storage capacity of 1.2 million bushels of grain (e.g. rice). The elevator had been receiving and drying rice during the harvest season. I spoke with Mr. Jeff Wright, Operating Manager, who stated that the facility would be rescreening the dryer next year. The dryer has screens that catch the rice hulls to keep them from being released from the dryer. These rice hulls have to be regularly removed from the dryer, so that the dryer does not catch fire. A rice hull stock pile was located on the parking lot. The rice hulls are generated from the rice receiving, handling, and drying operations at the grain elevator and are a biodegradable waste product. Dust emissions were observed being generated from a bin vent and from an elevator leg during this investigation; but these visible emissions were observed to be staying on Farmers Storage property. Farmers Storage, Inc. typically will achieve full storage capacity once during harvest season and then load out when the market is conducive to rice sales. This is not the case for grain elevators located on a navigable river (e.g. the Mississippi River) where the elevator receives grain (usually by truck) and ships grain (by barge on the river) throughout the calendar year.

October 2, we arrived at approximately 8:12 am and then began taking readings with the nasal ranger. Both Ruby and I took readings in two differ locations beyond the property line and at least fifteen minutes apart. No exceedances of odor were observed.

Later that day, at approximately noon, we arrived at the concern location after a call from Mike McCoy, from Allstar Transportation, regarding opac and odor from the plant. When we arrived, I observed emissions being produced where the drag slat conveyor loads asphalt into the silo prior to loadout.

We walked around the perimeter of the plant and tried to obtain a reading with the nasal, but detected only a slight odor. I also took opacity readin every fifteen seconds for 6 minutes of the slat conveyor/silo emissions. Readings taken of the facility appeared not to exceed opacity limits as per 10 CSR 10-6.220.

Friday October 5, 2018 I spoke with the concerned party, as a follow-up. I explained the odor regulation and told him contact us if there are further issues with odor or opacity.

They have found sand in their swimming pool and on their concrete patio. According to the caller, the problem began last August. The company knows about the problem and the company hired a third party air monitoring contractor who has found sand in their air monitoring equipment that originates from the sand mine.

I began the investigation by called the concerned party. I asked if she would like me to call Mississippi Sand to discuss this situation and she stated that she would like me to do that.

I made contact with Jason Bish with Mississippi Sand. Mr. Bish is stating that the air monitoring equipment collected air data for seven days. There was one day where the air monitor found 0.016 micrograms/cubic cm of sand in the air and this was supplied to the concerned party. Mr. Bish called this a trace amount of sand. He stated that the sand found in her swimming pool may be from their sand filter and that they offered to change their filter sand out for another that he has never verified that there is any sand on their property and that efforts to investigate sand on the property have been attempted but that the company can never find sand.



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Comments I went to the concerned party's address on 10/4/2018 to look for evidence of sand on surfaces and under downspouts. I did not see any evidence fugitive emissions. The concerned party showed me sand that came from their swimming pool which Mississippi Sand believes is coming from the swimming pool's sand filter.

Mississippi Sand has agreed to change the concerned party's sand media because they believe that it will show that the sand is coming from the filter system.

I spoke with Garry Pogue, EHS Manager with Mississippi Sand, and Bart Robinson, Plant Manager Mississippi Sand. Mr. Pogue stated they have looked at samples under a microscope taken from the concerned party's swimming pool and compared them with sand from their plant. He stated that the sand from the pool was shaped differently than the sand from their process. I asked if this was enough in his mind to determine that the sand from the pool was not theirs. He stated that he could NOT say that with 100% certainty, but based on their analysis, he believed that there was a good chance that the sand was not from their site. This is the reason that they want to change the pool filter media. He stated that the new media will look like sand until it is analyzed under a microscope. A microscopic analysis after the new media is installed will prove definitively one way or the other if sand is blowing from their site. I feel like this is pretty reasonable solution.

I talked to him about how this does not provide assurances to the concerned party in the short term as we won't have a final conclusion until next summer.

I also asked about taking a sample of the sand from the pool to analyze to see if there is any respiratory hazards involved with the sand. He stated the respiratory hazard associated with fugitive sand emissions would not be a visible so sampling the sand from the pool vacuum will not tell us much about your exposure to silica inhalation hazard. He explained that the only way to determine your potential exposure to silica is with the monitors that they have used in the past because this is collecting silica from the air. He reminded us that silica is not only contained in sandstone but in other rock like the gravel on roadways and other rock sources. So according to him, just because a monitor has detected silica, does not mean that it is from their site. Mr. Pogue agreed to continue monitoring the air around your house for the presence of silica using Sitex.

ECM Construction is contracted by American Missouri Water Company to complete the work.



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Comments Follow-up may be needed as further concerns are received.

I arrived at the source of the concern at approximately noon, accompanied by Mr. David Ruby (a coworker of the MDNR St. Louis Regional Office). We parked at the end of Maple Avenue, near Big Bend Boulevard, and walked along Maple Avenue towards the concerned party's house. While walking along Maple Avenue, I observed that the unpaved portion of the road had been recently watered. I also observed track-out along the driveways of the houses, due to the mud from the unpaved road.

We then approached the concerned party's house and discussed the concern. The concerned party mentioned that he didn't believe watering occurred on a consistent basis and that his car was consistently covered in dust. He also stated that he is concerned for his wife, who has an eye condition that may be getting worse due to the dust. I mentioned the possibility of closing the road and he stated that the City of Maplewood would not allow it.

After asking a few more questions, I then told him that we would be speaking with the employees working on the road, thanked him, and then Mr. Ruby and I walked towards where employees of ECM Construction were working, at end of the Maple Avenue where it intersects with Sutton Road.

We approached an employee, Mr. Gary Sanders, I introduced myself, and spoke with him regarding the concern. Mr. Sanders told us that a separate business waters the road and that they water the unpaved portion of the road around once to twice a day. He also responded that the foreman of the project is named Jared and to speak with him regarding any changes to their practices.

We thanked him and started to walk back towards the car, when Jared, the foreman, caught up with us. I gave him my card, introduced myself, and mentioned the concern. I recommended that he keep watering records and increase the frequency of the watering. Jared verbally agreed to begin keeping records and responded that he will try to make sure that the road is more consistently watered. Ruby and I then thanked him and left.

October 18, I called Jared (314-484-1274), the foreman of the project, to ask about the progress of the road. He stated that they will start to pave road on Monday (October 22) and will most likely finish by Thursday (October 18). I then called the concerned party to relay the information.
