RE: New Source Review Permit Amendment – Permit Number: #112006-006A
Project Number: 2017-07-018; Installation Number: 215-P053

Dear Mr. Carter:

On July 10, 2017, Air Pollution Control Program received your request to amend Permit #112006-006 in order to allow a portable asphalt plant to relocate to the site (PORT-0093, Project No. 2017-07-032). Specifically, this amendment will supersede Site Specific Special Condition 2 from a National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) limitation for particulate matter less than ten microns in diameter (PM₁₀) to daily throughput limitations on the stationary rock-crushing plant.

This change reflects the Air Pollution Control Program's updated construction industry policy "Ceasing the Use of Nomographs" dated May 1, 2016. Currently, Doss & Harper Stone Co., Inc. operates a stationary rock crusher at the site and is also permitted to operate a portable rock crusher (PORT-0497). This amendment applies specifically to the facility's stationary rock crusher daily production limits while Project No. 2017-07-060 applies to the facility's portable rock crusher daily production limits. Doss & Harper Stone Co., Inc. cannot operate with any other plants that have ambient impact limits based on the Air Pollution Control Program's nomographs. When other plants locate to the site, please refer to the special conditions of that plant's permit.

Doss & Harper Stone Co., Inc.'s stationary plant is permitted to operate at this site with other plants both owned and not owned by Doss & Harper as long as the following scenarios listed below in the table below are maintained.

To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

The special conditions listed in this permit were included based on the authority granted the Missouri Air Pollution Control Program by the Missouri Air Conservation Law (specifically 643.075) and by the Missouri Rules listed in Title 10, Division 10 of the Code of State Regulations (specifically 10 CSR 10-6.060). For specific details regarding conditions, see 10 CSR 10-6.060 paragraph (12)(A)10. "Conditions required by permitting authority."

1. **Superseding Condition**
 The conditions of this permit supersede Site Specific Special Condition 2 found in Construction Permit 112006-006 which was issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.
2. **Daily Production Limit For Rock-Crushing Plant**
 - A. Doss & Harper Stone Co., Inc.'s rock crushing plant shall limit its daily production based on Table 1 using Attachment A, or another equivalent form, that has been approved by the Air Pollution Control Program, including electronic forms.

3. **Record Keeping Requirement**
 Doss & Harper Stone Co., Inc. shall maintain all records required by this permit for not less than five years and make them available to any Missouri Department of Natural Resources' personnel upon request.
4. **Reporting Requirement**
 Doss & Harper Stone Co., Inc. shall report to the Air Pollution Control Program, Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 176, Jefferson City, MO 65102, no later than 10 days after any exceedances of the limitations imposed by this permit.
