Dear Mr. Ideker:

On June 25, 2019, Air Pollution Control Program received your request to amend Permit #122015-016 by eliminating Special Condition 6 that restricts concurrent operations from operating at that site.

In Permit #122015-016, the modeled impact at maximum capacity with controls was determined to be 127.53 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ for PM_{10} using nomographs. There was no daily limit when operating alone. To allow concurrent operation with any other plant, the stationary plant at Mosby North Quarry will be limited to a daily production limit of 8,280 tons of product per day which is equivalent to 80 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$. This change reflects the Air Pollution Control Program's updated construction industry policy "Ceasing the Use of Nomographs" dated May 1, 2016.

Ideker, Inc. – Mosby North Quarry is permitted to operate with other plants located at the site as long as the following scenarios are maintained. These scenarios are also summarized in the table below.

If you were adversely affected by this permit decision, you may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to Sections 621.250 and 643.075.6 RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed; if it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the administrative hearing commission, whose contact information is: Administrative Hearing Commission, United States Post Office Building, 131 West High Street, Third Floor, P.O. 

The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

The special conditions listed in this permit were included based on the authority granted the Missouri Air Pollution Control Program by the Missouri Air Conservation Law (specifically 643.075) and by the Missouri Rules listed in Title 10, Division 10 of the Code of State Regulations (specifically 10 CSR 10-6.060). 1. **Superseding Condition**
The conditions of this permit supersede Special Condition 6 found in the previously issued Construction Permit 122015-016 issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.
2. **Daily Production Limit**
Ideker, Inc. shall limit its daily production based on the table below using Attachment A, or another equivalent form, that has been approved by the Air Pollution Control Program, including electronic forms.

3. **Recordkeeping Requirement**
Ideker, Inc. shall maintain all records required by this permit for not less than five years and make them available to any Missouri Department of Natural Resources' personnel upon request.
4. **Report Requirement**
Ideker, Inc. shall report to the Air Pollution Control Program, Compliance/Enforcement Section by either email at AirComplianceReporting@dnr.mo.gov or by mail at P.O. Box 176, Jefferson City MO 65102, no later than ten days after any exceedances of the limitations imposed by this permit.
