Dear Mr. Hagen:

This letter will serve as your amendment to permit 072010-008 for Brunswick Freshwater Group Lebanon Missouri Facility formerly known as Lowe Boats, Inc. Please attach this amendment letter to your existing permit 072010-008 and the existing amendment 072010-008A.

According to your amendment request Brunswick Freshwater Group – Lebanon Missouri Facility (Brunswick), would like to amend permit 072010-008 to allow for the operation of four spray guns at one time. Special Condition 4.B. of permit 072010-008 requires that only one spray gun may be operated in each booth at a time.

In the most recently issued operating permit OP2013-012A, emission unit EU0190 Spray Booth Topcoat was renamed to EU0190 Spray Booth Camo. The reason for the description change was that the demand for camo painted boats has increased since the issuance of permit 072010-008 and the paint booth is now being used for camo painted boats instead of single color painting. Camo painting of each boat is a layering process that uses up to four spray guns at a time.

Permit 072010-008 states the bottleneck for the paint booths is the assembly portion of the plant. The maximum hourly design rates for the coatings applied in the paint rooms are indirectly limited by the number of boats that can be manufactured. There is no increase in potential paint usages that were used for the basis of calculations in permit 072010-008 for the camo process so there is no increase in the potential emissions of the application. The spray guns will remain the same type as those originally permitted in permit 072010-008.

If you were adversely affected by this permit decision, you may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to Sections 621.250 and 643.075.6 RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed



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filed on the date it is mailed; if it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the administrative hearing commission, whose contact information is: Administrative Hearing Commission, United States Post Office Building, 131 West High Street, Third Floor, P.O. 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SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

The special conditions listed in this permit were included based on the authority granted the Missouri Air Pollution Control Program by the Missouri Air Conservation Law (specifically 643.075) and by the Missouri Rules listed in Title 10, Division 10 of the Code of State Regulations (specifically 10 CSR 10-6.060). For specific details regarding conditions, see 10 CSR 10-6.060 paragraph (12)(A)10. "Conditions required by permitting authority."

1. Superseding Condition

The conditions of this permit supersede Special Condition 4 found in the construction permit 072010-008 issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.

2. Control Device Requirements

- A. Brunswick Freshwater Group - Lebanon Missouri Facility shall control particulate emissions from each spray gun using a paint booth equipped with high efficiency filters. The paint booths (EU0180, EU0190, EU0200, and EU0210) and high efficiency filters (CD8, CD9, CD10, and CD11) shall be maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. Replacement filters shall be kept on hand at all times.
- B. Only four spray guns may be operated in each paint booth (EU0101, EU0190, EU0200, and EU0210) at a time.
- C. Brunswick Freshwater Group - Lebanon Missouri Facility shall not replace the spray guns or modify the spray guns such that the current application rates as given in the application for permit 072010-008 are exceeded.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

3. Record Keeping and Reporting Requirements

- A.** Brunswick Freshwater Group - Lebanon Missouri Facility shall maintain all records required by this permit for not less than five (5) years and shall make them available immediately to any Missouri Department of Natural Resources' personnel upon request. These records shall include Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all materials used.

- B.** Brunswick Freshwater Group - Lebanon Missouri Facility shall report to the Air Pollution Control Program's Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 176, Jefferson City, MO 65102, no later than ten days after the end of the month during which any record required by this permit shows an exceedance of a limitation imposed by this permit.
