Dear Chief Wright:

On June 6, 2016, Kathy Kolb spoke with you about the permitted Drug Terminator that the Trenton Police Department owns. In the conversation, you brought to our attention that the Trenton Police Department, according to Special Condition 2.A. in Permit Number 102014-010, was not permitted to incinerate contraband or illegal drugs that were obtained by the Grundy County Sheriff Department. Both the Trenton Police Department and the Grundy County Sheriff Department are located in the same building and would like to share usage of the incinerator. After reviewing your permit for the Drug Terminator, Special Condition 2.A., restricting that only the Trenton Police Department shall burn the contraband/illegal drugs, has been superseded and removed as a requirement. This, therefore, allows the Grundy County Sheriff Department or any government agency to use the device in accordance with the permit.

Please add the attached Special Condition page to the previous Permit #102014-010.

If you were adversely affected by this permit decision, you may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to Sections 621.250 and 643.075.6 RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed; if it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the administrative hearing commission, whose contact information is: Administrative Hearing Commission, United States Post Office Building, 131 West High Street, Third Floor, P.O.
